Course Description: This TA is for the Proctored WRITTEN EXAM ONLY! This is Part 2 of a two-part process. Part 1 is the actual course that must be completed on-line, and can be found at www.vafire.com under 'higher education' and then click 'virtual classroom'. Carefully read and follow the instructions to create an account and take the course. When finished, print out the certificate of completion for the on-line class (part 1) and take it with you to the proctored exam (part 2). You are NOT state certified in HMA, and therefore do not meet the Loudoun County requirements, until you have successfully passed both parts of this testing process.

This course is a minimum requirement for all EMS personnel in Loudoun County. The course is designed for all emergency responders who may respond to hazardous material incidents. This course includes recognition and use of the DOT Emergency Response Guide Book.

PREREQUISITES: Completion of the ON-LINE Course at www.vafire.com and a copy of your course completion certificate are needed in order for you to sit for the proctored exam.
